## **Call for Papers**

The 11th International Congress on the **Chemistry of Cement** will be held May 11–16, 2003 in Durban, South Africa. The overall theme of the congress is cement's contribution to development in the 21<sup>st</sup> century. Proposed session topics include: Cement manufacture, quality control and assurance; Environmental issues; Characterization techniques; Low energy and special cements; Binder/admixture interactions; Cement extenders e.g. fly ash and slag; Durability of concrete; Chemical effects of concrete; and Cement and concrete applications in developing countries. Although the official deadline for submission is August 31, 2001, the Congress Scientific Committee will be seeking papers during 2002, and therefore, any persons wishing to submit must do so as soon as possible. Authors wishing to submit a paper should send an outline in electronic format in English and no longer than two pages, as an e-mail attachment to the Scientific Committee Chairman at doctech@iafrica.com.
